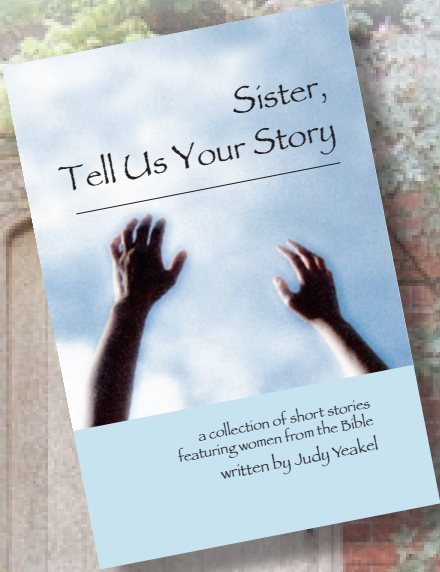

Then nothing else is ever said about her by Mark or anyone else. There aren't too many places that a woman is given such attention in the Gospels or any other part of the Bible for that matter.

Who was she? Where did she come from? But most importantly, where did she go and what did she do after this event? Surely, what she did and what Jesus said had some affect on her. The story, *Go Tell Your Story*, is the result, and it inspired me to write a series of narratives featuring other little-known women in the Bible.
